RESERVE POLICE OFFICER (LEVEL I & II) SALARY – Volunteer, non-paid FINAL FILING DATE: Open until filled.

The City of Seal Beach is recruiting Volunteer Reserve Police Officers. The Police Reserve Officer performs responsible part-time work in the protection of life and property through the enforcement of laws and ordinances, crime prevention and investigation. The Police Reserve Officer is appointed by and serves at the will of the Chief of Police.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge of laws, policies covering modern methods of police work.
- Ability to establish working relationships with fellow employees, City officials and the public.
- Education: Graduation from high school or equivalent.
- Experience & Training: Graduation from a P.O.S.T. approved academy (Level I) or completion of a P.O.S.T. Certified Level II program within the last three years.
- License: Possession of a valid driver's license.
- Physical Requirements: Must be in good physical condition, weight in proportion to height; vision 20/20 corrected and free from color blindness and normal hearing acuity.
- United States citizen or resident alien and have applied for U.S. citizenship at least one year prior to the application of employment.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: Applications shall be obtained from the Personnel Department, Seal Beach City Hall, 211 Eighth Street, Seal Beach, California 90740 or by calling (562) 431-2527 x.301. Applications may also be downloaded from our website at www.ci.seal-beach.ca.us. **Proof of Academy graduation or enrollment in Academy and POST certificate (if applicable) must be attached to the application.** Appointment is subject to any or all of the following: pre-employment medical, including substance abuse screening and EKG stress test, polygraph and fingerprint processes as well as background investigation. If selected, incumbent will be required to submit written identification proving eligibility to work in the United States. Selections will be made from an eligibility list established based on examination results.

Any qualified individual with a disability must provide reasonable notice to the City prior to the testing process that reasonable accommodation is required. EOE.

LATERAL/ACADEMY GRADUATE POLICE OFFICERS: Candidates also interested in the Lateral/Academy Graduate Police Officer position should submit their application for Lateral/Academy Graduate Police Officer only. There is no need to fill out both applications.
